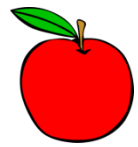




The Fruits of a Spirit Filled Life

Introduction: We often need a reminder that we have not always been in our current state of independence. Skill and knowledge came through education and experience. In a continued defense of his ministry, Paul reminds readers of an encounter with the Peter to demonstrate how *Genuine Faith* results in justification by faith alone.

I. C _____ (vv. 11-14)

“Opening his mouth, Peter said: 'I most certainly understand now that God is not one to show partiality, ³⁵but in every nation the man who fears Him and does what is right is welcome to Him.’” Acts 10:34-35

“And God, who knows the heart, testified to them giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He also did to us; ⁹and He made no distinction between us and them, cleansing their hearts by faith.” Acts 15:8-9

II. C _____ (vv. 15-16)

“Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith.” Galatians 3:24

“And do not enter into judgment with Your servant, For in Your sight no man living is righteous.” Psalm 143:2

“Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ...” Romans 5:1

III. C _____ (vv. 17-21)

“... for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live.” Romans 8:13

“Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?” Romans 6:3
