

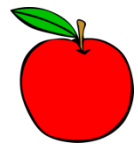


# The Fruits of a Spirit Filled Life

## A Genuine Righteousness

Galatians 3:1-14

April 3, 2016



**Introduction:** Sometimes we need to be reminded of our start to appreciate how far we have come. The false teachers told the believers in the region of Galatia that they needed to follow the traditions of Judaism to be truly saved. However, Paul reminds them of the Gospel he preached to them to reveal how to attain a genuine righteousness.

### I. Their S\_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 1-5)

“When I came to you, brothers, announcing the testimony of God to you, I did not come with brilliance of speech or wisdom. <sup>2</sup>For I didn’t think it was a good idea to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.”

1 Corinthians 2:1-2

“You, however, are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, since the Spirit of God lives in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.”

### II. Abraham’s E\_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 6-9)

“Abram believed the LORD, and He credited it to him as righteousness.”

### III. Redemption through C\_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 10-14)
