## Seeing the Truth Part 1: Gospel Driven Awe Psalm 32:1-5

Introduction:

Our view of reality is affected by our experiences. Our education, history, family and a host of other factors help tint the lenses by which we perceive the world. ### I. The B\_\_\_\_\_ of Debt (vv. 3-4)

"All of us have become like something unclean,  
and all our righteous acts are like a polluted  
garment;  
all of us wither like a leaf,  
and our iniquities carry us away like the wind."

"For my sins have flooded over my head; they are a  
burden too heavy for me to bear." Psalm 38:4

### II. The C\_\_\_\_\_ of Debt (v. 5)

but whoever confesses and renounces them will find

III. The R\_\_\_\_\_ from Debt (vv. 1-2)
