## The Church Is Settling Controversy

Acts 15:1-35 August 7, 2016

There is an inherent sense of injustice when it seems the rules have been changed midgame. The controversy of Acts 15 is introduced by some teaching of an additional requirement for Gentiles to become bonafide believers in Christ. That begins a debate between Paul and this new group. The answer to this conflict provides another confirmation of the Gospel and what is required of new believers. It also challenges us to look beyond what separates us to how we are united in Christ.
