I. A _____ in You (vv. 16-17)

“The Spirit told Philip, 'Go and join that chariot. Acts 8:29

II. S _____ to You (vv. 18-24)

“The wind blows where it pleases, and you hear its sound, but you don't know where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.” John 3:8

“Then He said, 'Go out and stand on the mountain in the LORD's presence.' At that moment, the LORD passed by... but the LORD was not in the wind... but the LORD was not in the earthquake... but the LORD was not in the fire. And after the fire there was a voice, a soft whisper.” 1 Kings 19:11-12
