## Lesson 2: Christ Colossians 1:13-23

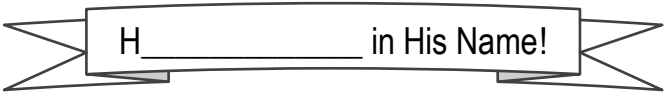
### Introduction:

“The Father and I are one.”

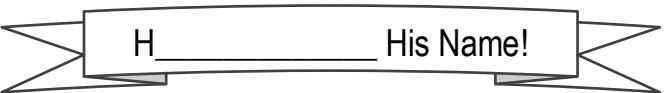
