



3 Foundational Characteristics of God

Psalm 102:25-27

Theology is defined as the study of, or the gaining of knowledge about, God. This is an extremely important task for all believers because we have a relationship with the God of this universe. Our exploration of 12 important theological topics will build a systematic understanding of essential doctrines, but the proper place to begin any study of theology is to explore the nature and character of God.
