



4 Great Needs of Every Person

Psalm 51:1-4

When exploring the doctrine of man, there are a variety of perspectives and sources from which we may draw our understanding. However, as we look through the lens of God's Word, we quickly discover that any theology of mankind becomes a theology of man's need because of sin. In Psalm 51, David confesses his four needs because of sin, and we discover the **4 Great Needs of Every Person:**

1. The Need for G_____ (v. 1)

"But your iniquities have built barriers
between you and your God,
and your sins have made Him hide His face from
you
so that He does not listen." Isaiah 59:2

"He saved us—
not by works of righteousness that we had
done,
but according to His mercy,
through the washing of regeneration
and renewal by the Holy Spirit." Titus 3:5

2. The Need for F_____ (v. 2)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of
God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."
Romans 6:23

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

3. The Need for R_____ (v. 3)

"He made the One who did not know sin to be sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."
2 Corinthians 5:21
