### 03: A Call To Sanctification, Part 2

1 Peter 2:4-12

Introduction:

Peter began his call to sanctification by reminding us of the costly nature of salvation and the reverent fear in which we should respond—a fear which leads us to obedience. The second part of His call to sanctification reveals the goal is to be holy so others will respond to His offer of salvation. Our role in the kingdom is to be:
