As of Thursday, June 25th plans have been changed regarding the Sunday Morning Worship Service, Sunday School, and Wednesday Prayer meeting & Bible Study at least for the next 2 weeks. We will hold our Sunday Morning Worship Service in the parking lot again on Sunday, June 28th and Sunday, July 5th at 10:30 a.m. Sunday School classes will not be held unless individual classes still wish to meet in larger areas of the church or online. Wednesday Night Study will again return to being posted online. We will evaluate our re-gathering details again soon. Please keep an eye on your email, our Facebook page & our website for updates on church events, activities, & services as info develops.

The Governor announced recently that we are remaining in Phase 2 of Louisiana's Roadmap to Resilience. We would like you to know that as we meet for Sunday School and Morning Worship, we will practice social distancing and using other precaution measures to stay safe during this time. We ask that you wear masks but it is not required. We have mask by the entrances if you would like to use one. Hand sanitizer stations are located in various places throughout the church. When we return to services inside the building, if you prefer limited access and away from larger groups, we have seating available in the Fellowship Hall and the Worship service will be live streamed there. Common areas, doors, and handrails are disinfected at least twice a week. We are excited about this opportunity for our church to gather again for worship and seeing you.

As far as decisions on the other services and activities returning, the Deacons decided that the Sunday Night Services will return August 2nd. Children and Youth activities on Sunday and Wednesday nights will return beginning August 5th.
