Jesus Christ, The Faithful Witness

Revelation 1:4-7

Physician Maxwell Maltz estimates that 95% people in our society feel inferior or millions are seriously handicapped by feelings of inadequacy. Often we experience depression, defeat, and even contemplate suicide.

The three main reasons are feelings of being unloved, guilt, and feeling unproductive. If you have ever had those feeling, I have good news for you. John says that Jesus, the Faithful Witness gives us:

I. A New Sense of _____: “He Loves Us”

II. A New _____: “He washed us from our sins”

III. A New _____: “He made us to be Kings and Priests”
