Deacons are encouraged to attend either attend in person or by Zoom Meeting. Everyone is asked to pray for our Deacons and their ministry for Many FBC.

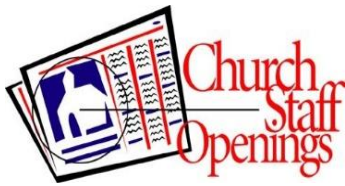
Finance Committee Meeting
