# From Dead to Dangerous

## John 11:1 – 12:9-11

Humans are made up of these parts: body, soul, and spirit. It is possible to be alive physically and dead spiritually. Paul says in 1 Timothy 5:6 "... she who live in pleasure is dead while she lives." and in Ephesians 2:1 "... you has He made alive who were dead in trespasses and sins." Jesus said in John 10:10 "... I came that they may have life, and that more abundantly." Romans 6:11 says, "... reason yourself to be dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

The story of the resurrection of Lazarus is a beautiful picture of how God wants to take us from being dead (spiritually) to being dangerous (to the devil).
