## Memorial Stones

### Joshua 24:14-28

Memorial Day has a long tradition of remembering and honoring the many men and women who lost their lives in defending our country. We owe a great debt of gratitude to them who gave us the freedom we enjoy today.

Memorials are far more common in scripture than you might think. For example, Passover was a memorial of God's deliverance from Egypt (Exodus 12); Mauna was a memorial of God's provision of bread (Exodus 16:32); the stones of the Ephod were reminders of how God brought the Israelites across the Jordan River (Joshua 4:7). In the New Testament, the Lord's Supper is a reminder of our salvation (Luke 22:19)

Memorial Stones in Joshua 24 remind us of:

- I. A \_\_\_\_\_ (24:14-15)
  1. A Personal Stand
  2. A Public Stand
  
- II. A \_\_\_\_\_ (24:16-24)
  1. May be shallow
  2. Should be sincere
  
- III. A \_\_\_\_\_ (24:25-28)
  1. A Stone
  2. A Statement

We may need to erect a memorial stone in our mind and heart that says, "I commit myself to God." I surrender fully to His will for my life.
