“Working Out Your Salvation”

Philippians 2:12-17

A Florida pastor was shaking hands with folks as they left the service. One said, “Pastor my cousin is in the hospital, could you visit her, they don’t have a church.” On Tuesday, the pastor was in Betsy’s room. As they talked, Betsy said, “We don’t go to church. We don’t think we’d live any differently if we did, so we just don’t go.”

What would you say to that statement? Can we come to the place where our relationship to God and His church don’t make any difference, in the way we live? If we are truly saved, Paul gives five important words about working out our salvation in Phil. 2:12-17.

- I. Spiritual Progress (2:12) “Work Out...”
- II. Spiritual Caution (2:12) “...with fear and troubling”
- III. Spiritual Harmony (2:14) “without complaining or disrupting”
- IV. Spiritual Purity (2:15) “blameless and harmless”
- V. Spiritual Witness (2:15-18) “...Shine as lights”

How are we doing in “Working out our salvation”? How mature are you? Are there evidences that you are growing in your relationship to God?
