

Iron Shoes for Rough Roads Deuteronomy 33:24-29

When famous preacher R.G. Lee retired he was asked if he could start over would he do anything differently. He said "Yes, I'd preach more encouragement". That is good advice because all of us need encouragement.

The past few weeks for Karen and me found us in great need of encouragement. God reminded me of a short passage in Deuteronomy has been an encouragement to me. Let's study it together: It teaches that.

- I. Life has Some Rough Roads (v.24)
- II. God Provides for His Children (v.25)
 - 1. He Provides Strength
 - 2. He Provides Peace
 - 3. He Provides Provisions
- III. God can be Trusted (v. 26-29)
 - 1. He is a God of Refuge (v.27)
 - 2. He is a God of Resourcefulness (v.37)
 - 3. He is a God of Redemption (v.29)

Whatever we may be going through, God knows, He cares, and He can be trusted. The promises are good because of the One who makes the promises!!

How to Join First Baptist Church of Many:

At the close of the service, a hymn of invitation will be sung. During this time, you may go forward and tell the pastor that you desire to unite with this church. You may share that you:
