If I Had One Last Sermon to Preach Deuteronomy 21:1-22

What would you say if you were in my place? Probably this is the last time I will speak from this pulpit. If this was your last time to speak what would you say?

Let's look at the last recorded thing Jesus said to Peter because it is what I think I would say to you.

- I. Accept Jesus's Invitation (v.12)
 - 1. Come to Me
 - 2. Fellowship with Me
- II. Mind Your Own Business (v.20-22)
 - 1. In Your Home
 - 2. In Your Church
 - 3. In Your World
- III. Follow Jesus (v. 15-21)
 - 1. Love Jesus
 - 2. Serve Jesus

If I could leave you with what I believe is the most important thing you can do it would be simply accept Jesus, do what He wants you to do, and serve him faithfully until He comes again!!

How to Join First Baptist Church of Many:
