Sermon Notes:

Church Family,

God's delays are worth the wait

Jesus heard his friend Lazarus was sick, but rather than rushing to the bedside of his dear friend, he tarried two extra days. Unlike most of us, Jesus was concerned with the rhythm of heaven, not the rhythm of the rat race. By the time he arrived in Bethany, Lazarus was already dead. Lazarus's sisters, Martha and Mary, had asked Jesus for help, trusting that if anyone could rescue their brother from the disease that plagued him, it was Jesus. But He didn't answer on their timetable. Certainly, Jesus could have traveled to Bethany as soon as He heard the news and could have healed Lazarus from his illness.

But Jesus delayed to bring a greater miracle-raising Lazarus from the dead. There may be times when it seems God is silent. You may wonder why He's left you in your current situation. You may even begin to doubt His concern for you. But remember; "Your Father knows the things you need before you ask him" (Matt. 6:8) and He "is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think" (Eph.3:20). He is also working for your good (Rom.8:28). So in the waiting, remember that just as He did for Lazarus, He may be bringing you a greater miracle when all is said and done.

Father, thank you for your answers to prayers. Help me to trust that your timing is always right.

Please continue to pray for the Pastor Search Committee, the pastor God has out there somewhere for our church and that we will find him in God's time.
