



Notes from Pastor Search:

Church Family,

Grace and peace to all in the name of Jesus our Savoir!

Paul had a deep love for the church in Rome and longed to go there and minister to them.

For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I mention you always in my prayers, asking that somehow by God's will I may now at last succeed in coming to you. Romans 1:9-10

Though he prayed a way would be made available and that doors would be opened he didn't know by what means or method God would provide a way. But he had faith God would. Closed doors can be frustrating. Paul knew exactly how that felt in his desire to go to the church in Rome. God did answer and open doors to make this possible, Paul just didn't know God's method of getting him there was a prisoner in chains.

The search committee has had doors close that we didn't see coming or expect. Our flesh will naturally become frustrated and anxiety will build if we don't constantly pray and strive to align ourselves with God's plan. Please pray for renewed strength, commitment, and unity in completing our task. Not to become complacent, yet not impatient, but in His timing. Scripture tells us God has plans to prosper us, to give us hope and a future; (Jeremiah 29:11). We should always stand on the fact that the door He provides is eternal and no other has authority.
