


We have some upcoming dates open for Flowers for the Sanctuary. Please contact the church office so we can schedule you for a date.

Sermon Notes:

Church Family,

Pray with expectancy.

Matthew 2:9

After hearing the King they went on their way, and there it was – the star they had seen at its rising. It led them until it came and stopped above the place where the child was.

"When you pray for rain, carry an umbrella" is an old adage suggesting we expect results when we pray, It's a sad thing to pray with no anticipation of results. Praying specifically may help address this problem. Too often we pray in "bless this or that" generalities, without giving a thought to what we hope to see take place. In so doing, we deprive ourselves of the excitement of seeing God at work around us and experiencing the joy of answered prayer. How much better to pray specifically for God to answer, even if His answer is sometimes not what we had hoped for. When we pray, let's commit ourselves to do so with hope, truly expecting the Lord to respond. He may have something special in store.

James 1:6 But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

Matthew 18 "Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven.
