Pray in Preparation.

In 2 Timothy, Paul is writing to Timothy, who is in transition and will soon be the leader of a church. Paul reminds Timothy that he has what it takes. Paul has prepared Timothy for the job ahead. He has faith and love in Christ Jesus. He has the gospel message. He has the Holy Spirit guiding him.

2 Timothy 1:13-14 (NLT) “Hold on to the pattern of wholesome teaching you learned from me – a pattern shaped by the faith and love that you have in Christ Jesus. Through the power of the Holy Spirit who lives within us, carefully guard the precious truth that has been entrusted to you.”

God has entrusted First Baptist Church of Many with the truth of the gospel message, with the love of Jesus in our hearts, and with the Holy Spirit.
