



#### Notes from Pastor Search Committee:

Church Family,

From your search committee, we thank you for continued prayers, encouragement, and patience through this process. As we pray for His guidance, unity, and clear vision we will patiently wait for the Lord's will and the shepherd He is preparing for our church.

Psalm 27:14- "Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord."

David knew from experience what it meant to wait for the Lord. He had been anointed king at age 16, but didn't become king until he was 30. During the interim, he had been chased by through the desert by a jealous King Saul. David had to trust and wait on God for the fulfillment of His promise to reign.

Waiting for God is not always easy. Often we feel He isn't going to answer our prayers. By thinking this way implies he is not in control but we truly know He is in total control of all things and we must trust and wait for things to come in His timing not ours. God's answered prayers are worth waiting for and often He uses this waiting period to refresh, renew, and teach us.
