First Responders Breakfast



Notes from Pastor Search Committee:

Church Family,

While we carry on and continue to seek God and to seek the man he has to lead our church, let's be encouraged by the words of the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Philippians. At the time Paul writes this letter he is in prison, so he was not present with the church in Philippi to remind them of Jesus' words and his ministry.

"Dear friends, you always followed my instructions when I was with you. And now that I am away, it is even more important. Work hard to show the results of your salvation, obeying God with deep reverence and fear. For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him." Philippians 2:12-13 (NLT)

Paul is very clear in other passages that salvation is by grace alone through faith in Christ. But he is urging them to **show the results of their salvation**. Paul is reminding us that we should work hard to obey God and work together to be a light to our community, holding firm to the Word.

The Message says it like this, "...keep it up. Better yet, redouble your efforts. Be energetic in your life of salvation, reverent and sensitive before God." (MSG)

And be confident that it is God working in us, giving us the desire and the power to do what pleases him. Paul's encouragement continues with verse 14, "Do everything without complaining and arguing, so that no one can criticize you."
