

#### Notes from Pastor Search Committee:

Church Family,

Grace and peace to all in the name of Jesus our Savoir!

He waited seven days, the time appointed by Samuel. But Samuel did not come to Gilgal, and the people were scattering from him. So Saul said, "Bring the burnt offering here to me, and the peace offerings." And he offered the burnt offering. As soon as he had finished offering the burnt offering, behold, Samuel came. And Saul went out to meet him and greet him. Samuel said, "What have you done?" And Saul said, "When I saw that the people were scattering from me, and that you did not come within the days appointed, and that the Philistines had mustered at Michmash, I said, 'Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and I have not sought the favor of the Lord.' So I forced myself. and offered the burnt offering." And Samuel said to Saul, "You have done foolishly. You have not kept the command of the Lord your God, with which he commanded you. For then the Lord would have established your kingdom over Israel forever. But now your kingdom shall not continue. The Lord has sought out a man after his own heart, and the Lord has commanded him to be prince over his people, because you have not kept what the Lord commanded you." 1 Samuel 13:8-14

Not too soon after Saul was anointed king, he was blessed with some victories and the people were pleased with their new king. Then before a battle with the Philistines, Saul was told to wait seven days on Samuel to make a burnt offering for the Lord God to give His blessings for victory. But Samuel doesn't show in that time. Meanwhile, the Philistines are gathering for war and Saul's men are beginning to scatter. In our flesh, it is not hard to see why Saul becomes impatient and takes it upon himself to make the burnt offering. Seemingly his fear is to lose the battle, but also his stature and notoriety with the people. Relying on himself, and not obeying and trusting God to take care of both, he takes matters into his own hands. Big mistake - "You have done foolishly and not kept the command of the Lord your God". As Christ followers, we should always search the Lord's word and know what His command (will) for our life is. Not to become impatient when things don't happen as we think they should. Fearful that somehow God is not sovereign and in complete control of everything on, above, and under the earth. Patience has fast become an unpopular virtue, especially in this fast-paced world of instant gratification. Our best option is and will always be to never get ahead of God!
