





Sermon Notes:

Notes from the Pastor Search Committee:

Church Family,

Grace and peace to all in the name of Jesus our Savoir!

"I know your deeds and your toil, and your patient endurance, and that you cannot tolerate those who are evil, and have tested and critically appraised those who call themselves apostles (special messengers, personally chosen representatives, of Christ), and [in fact] are not, and have found them to be liars and impostors; and [I know that] you [who believe] are enduring patiently and are bearing up for My name's sake, and that you have not grown weary [of being faithful to the truth]. But I have this [charge] against you, that you have left your first love [you have lost the depth of love that you first had for Me]. Revelation 2:2-4 (AMP)

As we read the letters to the early churches, we must not forget they are messages from the Lord Jesus Christ. Warnings for disobedience yes, but we also see the love of the Chief Shepherd searching and calling back those before they stray too far. Here the Savior affirms the Ephesian's positive actions. They were a hard-working group of believers full of fortitude, gate-keepers of the truth, and showed patient endurance in bearing up under hardship. However, like the early church, as the world and our adversary creeps in focus on the love for Christ and reliance on how He perfectly meets all our needs gets blurred. Problems arise, things break, and we lose sight of who can fix it. Jesus is the source of all our strength. This time of year we are reminded of His birth. More importantly, may we re-focus on the essence of the source of our eternal salvation and search our hearts for the depth of love that we first had for Him!

As we all continue to pray for our church's next pastor may we also remind ourselves who our Chief Shepherd is and all the problems and needs of the church, and our lives, are met in Jesus Christ. He and He alone is the answer to our needs and the solution to our problems.
