
2025 Sanctuary Flower Calendar is now open! Call the church office today to reserve a Sunday or two to place flowers. The dates are

As it is said, "Today, if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion." So we see that they were unable to enter because of unbelief. Hebrews 3:15&19 (ESV)
