
time to change the batteries in your smoke detectors.

In the book of James, written by James the brother of Jesus, he writes to expose the hypocritical practices and to teach the right Christian behavior. The central theme of James' letter, around which he supplies practical advice on living the Christian life is, that genuine faith will inevitably produce good deeds.
