Notes from the Pastor Search Committee:

Dear Church Family,

Setbacks can become blessings.

"But he shook the snake off into the fire and suffered no harm." Acts 28:5

When Paul was a prisoner and shipwrecked on the island of Malta, it might have seemed that his ministry had suffered one to many setbacks – and then, on top of that, a poisonous snake bit him! But Paul seemed to understand not every setback is what it seems. He shook off the serpent into the fire and went on continued about his business. The locals thought a bite like that meant he would soon die, but he didn't; God healed him. The people were so astonished that they thought Paul was a God. Soon, Paul was invited into the home of the island's leading citizen, and God used him to heal the man's father, who was terribly ill. Many more people came for healing, and Paul had the opportunity to tell everyone about Jesus. God used Paul's setbacks to lead him to that very moment. So next something doesn't go the way you had hoped, look for God to open an unexpected door.

We ask that you continue to pray for the Pastor Search Committee in our task of finding the pastor and shepherd that God has for our church. During our search we have had many setbacks and doors closed, but we know that in God's time, He will open that unexpected door to the pastor He has chosen for our church.
