Notes from the Pastor Search Committee:

Dear Church Family,

The Book of Jude is a very short letter. It is a reminder for the church to stay strong in the face of false teaching. He wrote with great passion, warning believers against heresy that was infiltrating the church.

Jude begins his letter saying, *"Dear friends, I had been eagerly planning to write to you about the salvation we all share, but now I find that I must write about something else, urging you to defend the faith that God has entrusted once for all time to his holy people."* Jude 3 (NLT)

We have been entrusted with the Word of God. We need to stay strong. We need to guard against false teaching. We need to come together to build one another up, to pray for one another, and to wait expectantly for the pastor God has for us.

Later in Jude 20-21, he says pretty much that. *"But you, dear friends, must build each other up in your most holy faith, pray in the power of the Holy Spirit, and await the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will bring you eternal life. In this way, you will keep yourselves safe in God's love."* Jude 20-21 (NLT)
