Church Nursery & Sunday School Classes Available for all Children

We are so enthusiastic as we are starting to see young families coming to First Baptist Church in Many, especially the children. For children from birth to 4 years age, we have a nursery. This is available on Sunday Mornings for Sunday School and Church Services and on Wednesday Evenings for Prayer Meeting/Bible Study. The Nursery is located at the top of the stairs to the left. We have Sunday School class for Pre K ages 4-5 and is located right next door to the nursery. For our older children grades 1-6 the Sunday School Class is located downstairs at the bottom of the stairs on the left. Again we are so excited to have your family start attending First Baptist Church.

How to Join First Baptist Church of Many:

At the close of the service, a hymn of invitation will be sung. During this time, you may go forward and tell the pastor that you desire to unite with this church. You may share that you:

- ◆ *Want to receive Christ as Lord and Savior and follow Him in baptism.*
- ◆ *Have already trusted Christ as Savior and want to signify that commitment through Believer's baptism by immersion.*
- ◆ *Want to transfer your letter of membership from another Baptist church of like faith and order to this church.*
- ◆ *Want to join the Church by statement of your prior conversion and symbolic baptism by immersion (when no letter is obtainable from a Baptist church of like faith and order).*
