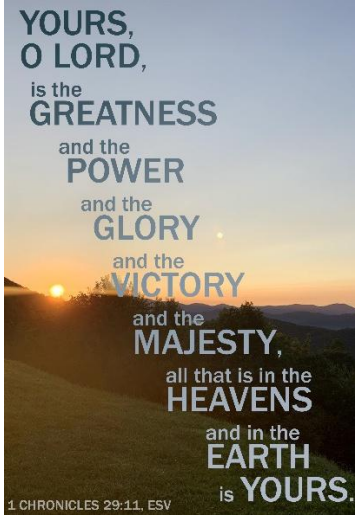

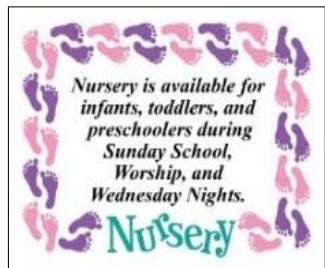

Wednesday, April 22nd @ 6 p.m.

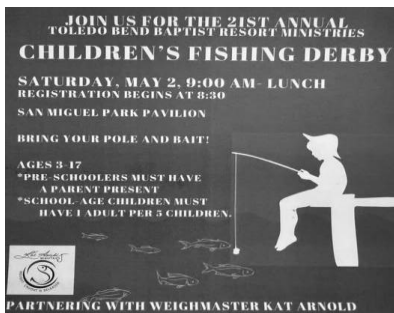
There are several important items to be discussed and voted on. Church members are urged to attend. Come be a part of the business matters and decisions of the church.

Mother's Day Breakfast

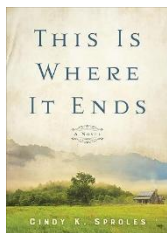
Sunday, March 10th @ 9:00 a.m.
